SITTING WITH SCRIPTURE

Our natural sympathies are probably with Martha in today's Gospel reading. On one level, Martha and Mary have traditionally been taken to represent two dimensions of institutional life in the Church, that active life and the contemplative life. The Church needs both. We need those who work in the world to spread the Gospel and Christian values and who work for fairness and for peace. We also need those who support them in prayer. We need work and prayer. They are not rivals but allies, partners in the work of the Gospel.

On a second level, Martha and Mary also stand for two dimensions inside each one of us. One is the desire to achieve, to work, to raise a family, to make a difference and to accomplish something. That's the Martha dimension. The other need we all have, which is unique to human beings, is the need to pause, to look at where our life is going, to listen to the Lord. That is the Mary dimension which is unique to us. Prayer and reflection give us the rudder to guide our life. Otherwise we're like a leaf that the wind pushes anywhere.

A third has to do with our prayer. Martha and Mary represent two kinds of prayer in our life. We can so easily limit prayer to "saying prayers" – the Martha part – that we forget the prayer of silent listening to the Lord that is represented by Mary in this Gospel.

This kind of prayer, "being with the Lord," is necessary for a mature and strong spiritual life. Being in the quiet presence of Christ gives us a chance to pull all the separate strands of our life together. It is like stopping and looking at a road map to compare where we are with our eternal destination.

Through this prayer of listening, we begin to recognize the presence of God who comes to us in all kinds of unexpected ways as the Lord does to Abraham in today's first reading, in the disguise of visitors. The Lord enters our life in all kinds of ways through good times and bad times. Everything that happens to us is seeded with grace. Quiet prayer, listening to the Lord, helps those seeds grow.

Pre-Authorized Giving

My Mom once said "money can't buy you the things that are most important, but boy do you still need it".

If you looked around at Mass this Sunday you noticed that in the summer months people take the opportunity to go on vacation and enjoy the weather. All good things. I myself will be taking advantage of this in August. But without intending it, what that does is create a boom and bust cycle in our finances. We do well from October to June and struggle July through September.

However, I might ask that you think about Pre-Authorized Giving. You can sign up for this in the Parish Office. This is a system where money is automatically taken from your account and transferred to the Parish. You obviously set your own amount and it appears on your statement. It is taken only for the regular offerings (no money is removed for second collections). Even when you go on vacation, your donation is made and it allows for an even cash flow for the year. Some people say "well when I am at Mass and it's time for the collection, I feel compelled to put something in". Many people do. Those on Pre-Authorized Giving still get envelopes and simply put a blank one in, writing on the envelope PAG.

An Angel is Coming



If you have been over at our cemetery since the expansion, you have noticed at the end of the road is a turn-around. You will notice rods sticking out of the center. It has always been the desire when the cemetery was expanded not only to make this a place to lay our loved ones to rest, but to remind those who visit that our true home is in heaven and that in Christ there is no death. We on earth are members of Christ's body and the society of

the Church as were our loved ones, and, as they still are, nothing separates those bound in Christ. There is no veil that completely cuts us off from them. While our loved ones are never far away, in Christ there is still a mystical union connecting all of us. This is why when we pray for them and in prayer speak to them, we can still, at times, feel them close to us, or indeed they are Christ Himself revealed. As quoted when he said "God the Father is the God or Abraham, Isaac and Jacob" (Mt 22:32), not he was the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. He never speaks of the deceased in the past tense. They are with us. I have been discussing with the cemetery board how to represent this in a way that also honors our blessed dead buried at the cemetery. We have decided on a statue of an angel. You can see a picture of it at the back of the church on the bulletin board.

Keeping to custom, there will be space on the sides and back of the statue for those who wish a special remembrance of family members. The front of the statue will contain words of universal remembrance. The donation for this is \$200.00. It will be shown on your tax receipt next January. Due to space limitations, and, so as to offer this option to as many people as possible, we are asking that only one name be given per donation, (a maximum of 18 characters including spaces).
