Serving God in this Pilgrimage

The Gospel speaks of the results of the first mission to which Jesus had sent the twelve Apostles. Jesus now invites them to get away from the people and rest a while. But the people did not want to lose sight of them! They kept coming to them from all directions. On seeing this, Jesus showed great compassion for "they were like sheep without a shepherd: and he began to teach them many things" (Mk 6.34).

The readings remind us today of the theme to do good. Our Lord has called us from all eternity to be an essential part of His Mystical Body, and therefore, apostles in the world. In the three readings of today, this concept is emphasized:

God does not take us as a group, but as individuals, when it is a matter of carrying out His mandates. I am not you, and you are not me, I and you, all of us, each one has a special duty in God's plan, with distinctive gifts and talents to help us on the journey. Every man and woman has a special calling to the apostolate which may resemble that of another, but in reality is not the same. There is no man or woman who is the "double" of another person in the religious sphere, and this will be so till the end of the world.

In the Gospel we see Christ, who is the model of every good pastor. Jesus looked at the vast crowd and showed compassion, for "they were like sheep without a shepherd" (Mk 6:34). All creatures need a guide and priests have been chosen by God to be leaders of His flock each in his own way.

Pray then that we priests carry out our duties with the greatest diligence and dedication. Lastly, St. Paul refers to in his letter to the Ephesians: "In Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near in the blood of Christ:....through Him we both have access in one Spirit to the Father!" (Eph 2:13, 18). We must break down the barriers of hostility and do good always as Christ, our Peace, has done. No matter where we may be, we must always be faithful and solicitous, as the good shepherd.
