

## SITTING WITH SCRIPTURE

A great deal can be said about the Lord's Prayer because it is both a prayer and a school of prayer. We can reflect on the intimacy, the surrender and the trust it displays.

There is, first of all, its intimacy. Jesus says that when we Christians pray, we should say "Father". As Christians we have a special relationship with the Father through His Son. We can speak to the Father with all the familiarity that implies. He is also Father of us all. God is "our Father".

Secondly, the Lord's Prayer teaches us surrender. The first group of petitions acknowledges that God's name must be hallowed, His Kingdom has priority and Matthew's Gospel adds that His will must be done. We give ourselves to the care and providence of the Father. We might not fully understand what is happening in our life or why, but we trust that God is also present. Ultimately His will is our peace.

Finally, the Lord's Prayer concludes with a series of petitions through which we present all our needs to the Father. Any prayer that does not come from our real self, that uses rhetorical flourishes to flatter God rather than reflect what is in our heart may be prayer but it is not the way Jesus prayed. The Lord's Prayer teaches us to trust God with the truth about ourselves.

# **Pre-Authorized Giving**

My Mom once said "money can't buy you the things that are most important, but boy do you still need it".

If you looked around at Mass this Sunday you noticed that in the summer months people take the opportunity to go on vacation and enjoy the weather. All good things. I myself will be taking advantage of this in August. But without intending it, what that does is create a boom and bust cycle in our finances. We do well from October to June and struggle July through September.

However, I might ask that you think about Pre-Authorized Giving. You can sign up for this in the Parish Office. This is a system where money is automatically taken from your account and transferred to the Parish. You obviously set your own amount and it appears on your statement. It is taken only for the regular offerings (no money is removed for second collections). Even when you go on vacation, your donation is made and it allows for an even cash flow for the year. Some people say "well when I am at Mass and it's time for the collection, I feel compelled to put something in". Many people do. Those on Pre-Authorized Giving still get envelopes and simply put a blank one in, writing on the envelope PAG.

# An Angel is Coming



If you have been over at our cemetery since the expansion, you have noticed at the end of the road is a turn-around. You will notice rods sticking out of the center. It has always been the desire when the cemetery was expanded not only to make this a place to lay our loved ones to rest, but to remind those who visit that our true home is in heaven and that in Christ there is no death. We on earth are members of Christ's body and the society of the Church as were

our loved ones, and, as they still are, nothing separates those bound in Christ. There is no veil that completely cuts us off from them. While our loved ones are never far away, in Christ there is still a mystical union connecting all of us. This is why when we pray for them and in prayer speak to them, we can still, at times, feel them close to us, or indeed they are Christ Himself revealed. As quoted when he said "God the Father is the God or Abraham, Isaac and Jacob" (Mt 22:32), not he was the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. He never speaks of the deceased in the past tense. They are with us. I have been discussing with the cemetery board how to represent this in a way that also honors our blessed dead buried at the cemetery. We have decided on a statue of an angel. You can see a picture of it at the back of the church on the bulletin board.

Keeping to custom, there will be space on the sides and back of the statue for those who wish a special remembrance of family members. The front of the statue will contain words of universal

remembrance. The donation for this is \$200.00. It will be shown on your tax receipt next January. Due to space limitations, and, so as to offer this option to as many people as possible, we are asking that only one name be given per donation, (a maximum of 18 characters including spaces). There is room for about 150 names on the base. If you would like to add the name of a loved
