FROM THE DESK OF FATHER BONIFACE PERRI



Recently, there has been some inquiries about our cemetery and the services that are or are not being provided.

It must be remembered that the Holy Martyrs of Japan Cemetery was founded as a small churchyard alongside a country chapel. As we grew and moved the church, the cemetery remained a small country cemetery where we can lay our beloved near to us as we await the resurrection. There was no financial or structural contingencies in place to transform it into anything other than it is. It is for this reason, that the prices for inturnment are much lower than many other places.

The request for more services in the cemetery would require a full time caretaker. It is simply not possible to sustain such a presence. Care and maintenance is done according to provincial standards, once a week, currently on Mondays. There is a company that comes to cut the grass and empty the garbage bins, furthermore the repairs to sunken graves and other maintenance is done when it comes to our attention. We thank all those who have brought issues of repairs to our attention and please accept our commitment to address these issues in a more expedient time frame.

However, keeping our cemetery neat and tidy is the responsibility of all who bring flowers and plants into it. There are a few simple actions we can all take: firstly, if you notice the bins are full do not just over fill the garbage bins. The dead flowers often become garbage on the ground or over and around the graves of loved ones. Also remember if you plant gardens they must be maintained to a small size. This not only reduces the amount of garbage but more seriously over grown shrubs and trees may damage or cover up the graves beside them, they may need to be removed. We understand that they may have emotional value added to them, but the bylaws in this regard are strict for the fairness of all. If you plant any garden please make sure they can be maintained in the long term. Also, please note that while there is a duty to maintain graves which have been damaged by the elements, vandalism or time we are not responsible for theft or the destruction of any other items left beside or on the graves. To help us maintain the grounds, please take home or dispose of privately any unwanted items as well as any larger clay or plastic pots. There have also been several other requests we are looking into. The first is the repair of the older section of the cemetery. Secondly, if a tank of water may be made available, and lastly if more garbage bins may be placed around the graves. To address these issues in turn: we have contacted a company that specializes in grave restoration and we hope to begin work in late September or October. Secondly, we are planning to put in a water tank. If God's providence allows, it will be installed as soon as reasonably possible. Lastly, the issues of more bins will be brought to the next cemetery board meeting for consultation. I understand that the concerns that we all have for our loved ones at the cemetery is great and that for many this is a very sensitive topic. I thank you in advance for your understanding and cooperation.
