The way Catholics celebrate the Eucharist follows a standard form. We call this the Order of Mass. It is comprised of 4 main parts: Introductory Rites, the Liturgy of the Word, the Liturgy of the Eucharist, and the Concluding Rites.

In 2000, Blessed John Paul II issued a 3rd Edition of the Roman Missal based on the renewal of the sacred liturgy called for by the bishops during the Second Vatican Council. Originally produced in Latin, the test have been translated into English using a careful method to preserve, as much as possible, the full meaning of the text. On the first Sunday of Advent 2011, we will begin to use this new translation of the Roman Missal. prayers and acclamations will sound different from the ones we now employ. Therefore, we will need to learn the revised translation of the parts of the Mass. September, we will begin to introduce these new translations. 
