

REFLECTION

The desert is difficult.

It's a barren, lonely, and a harsh place to be in. Despite knowing that, Our Lord, led by the Holy Spirit, ventured out into the desert in order to prepare Himself for the great mission the Father was about to send Him on. When we choose to follow the Lord Jesus Christ, we too are being called out into the desert. To get away from distractions, to prepare our minds, hearts, and wills, for the mission the Father sends us on. But most of all, we are called into the desert to finally encounter our very selves and how we see our very person in Jesus Christ.

The Church journeys into the desert during Lent so that we may come to realize and once again renew our baptismal promises. Through the Sacraments, Scriptures, and Spiritual Practices that we take on during this season, God reveals to us how thirsty our souls are for Him. When we renew these promises, we reject the lie that sin tells us about ourselves, we remember the love and mercy that the Father has for all of us, we re-center ourselves with the core of our being, the Son, Jesus Christ, Our Lord, and we renew our commitment to be transformed and be led by the Spirit.

When we go into the desert, this is the water the Lord is providing for all of us to fill that thirst. Are you willing to be led by the Spirit to these renewing waters to be renewed and nourished for the mission? Are you willing to face your sins and turn away from them in order to be one with Jesus Christ? Are you willing to allow yourself to be forgiven and loved, so that you may truly be a son or daughter of God the Father?

The desert is difficult.

But by going through the barren, lonely, and harsh place, we can find not only God, but also ourselves - to be transformed into the saints we're all called to be.
