

FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT

GOING WITH GOD

Father Timothy Bellamah, O.P.

It is important for us to remember that unlike most people who know our faults, God loves us in spite of them, warts and all. It is all the more comforting to realize that God loves us in spite of our actual sins, that no evil deed of ours can cause him to stop loving us and place us beyond the reach of his mercy.

So it is understandable that people often say that God loves us just as we are. But this remark is often made to suggest that God would somehow love us less if he were to call us to change. On this way of thinking, any requirement on God's part for us to transform our ways of thinking and acting would suggest that he is insulting his own creative work. Taken for granted in this view is that the pursuit of our natural inclinations is justifiable and good, that we have no need for redemption.

After the woman's accusers leave, Jesus alone remains with her, as he alone is sinless. The only one there who could condemn her without injustice replaces a barbaric application of the Mosaic law with the logic of pardon. But his mercy takes the form of forgiving her sin, not condoning it. Perhaps the latter course of action would have been more tactful, more polite. But it would have been no act of mercy. The logic of pardon, of forgiveness, presupposes acknowledgement of and contrition for a wrong done. Neither this woman nor any one of us can be forgiven unwillingly. To enjoy God's mercy, we must be willing to receive it by acknowledging our need for it. Christ loves this woman too much to leave her where she is, as he loves each one of us too much to leave us where we are. Why would anyone want to be left behind?
