MASS MINUTES

WEEK 4:

The traditional practice of the Church from her very early centuries has been to build churches in such a way that the faithful enter the church facing towards the East. There are a number of historical and theological reasons behind facing east in liturgical prayer. Historically, it is a natural development from the Jewish practice of facing towards Jerusalem and the temple during prayer. Theologically, the East is symbolically where God is. God led the people of Israel East, out of Egypt to the Promised Land where they would worship him and build His Temple where God would dwell with them. The East is also where the Sun rises and where light comes to the world that is otherwise lifeless and in darkness. The Sun is the symbol for Christ who brings the light of Truth into the world and enables us to escape from the darkness of sin and enter into the true Promised Land which is Heaven where we will enjoy the fullness of life, dwelling with God in a way far greater than the Israelites did and greater then we do now in His Church. For as members of His Church, we do dwell with God in a way that is greater then the Israelites did. God dwelt among the Israelites as formless cloud and fire (Exodus 13:21) He dwells among us bodily as Christ in the Blessed Sacrament in every church.

Here is a fun fact! Did you know the front of the church is where the altar is and where Jesus is (in the tabernacle). The back of the church is considered where we enter!

Activity: This week, when you get up and see the Sun think about how it symbolizes Christ who brings the light of Truth into the world and enables us to escape from the darkness of sin.
