FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT

Jesus used the illustration of the "grain of wheat" to show how God brings life from death and good fruit through patience and suffering. Seeds by themselves are worthless and lifeless. Only when the seed is destroyed by burying it in the ground, can it rise to new life and bear fruit. Jesus' obedience and death on the cross obtain for us freedom and life in the Holy Spirit. His cross frees us from the tyranny of sin and death and shows us the way of perfect love and readiness to lay down our lives in sacrificial service for the good of others. If we want to receive the abundant new life and the fruit of the Spirit which the Lord Jesus freely offers us, then the "Outer Shell" of our fallen sinful nature must first be broken and be put to death. When we "die" to ourselves to our rebellious sinful nature and willful rejection of God's commandments - we receive God's forgiveness and the lifechanging power of the Holy Spirit which frees us to love and serve others, and follow God faithfully. It is God's free gift of grace (his blessing and favor towards us) and the transforming power of the Holy Spirit that enables us to live and serve joyfully as sons and daughters of God. Pruning and bearing good fruit in Christ means that what is contrary to God's will must be "put to death". God gives us grace to say "yes" to his will and the strength we need to reject whatever is contrary to his commands and plan for our lives. The Lord promises that we will bear much "fruit" for him, if we choose to deny ourselves for his sake and embrace his will for our lives.

Lord Jesus. let me be wheat sown in the earth. to be harvested for you. I want to follow wherever you lead me. Give me fresh hope and joy in serving you all the days of my life.
