## A LENTEN RETREAT FOR THE WEEK

Third Sunday of Lent: The Samaritan woman, like many, wants happiness and fulfilment in her life and her search before she met Christ to be married five times and now to be living with a sixth man. Does the Lord Jesus condemn her? In one sense, yes. He clearly places the truth before her and in one sense, no, He thirsts for her faith, He elicits it. "I came into the world, not to condemn the world, but in order that the world be saved". (Jn 3:17)

She too is valuable to Christ and worthy of His love. From this encounter we learn two valuable lessons. The first is that there is no llife that can't be redeemed by His love. We also learn that true happiness, that can guench our thirst and bestill our searching hearts, cannot be found in the things of this world or the people of this world. We seek for a joy that is eternal, we seek for our 'happily ever after', we seek for love itself, for God.

(2 Kings 5:1-15)

Nathan was searching for you Lord is the extra ordinary. He wanted to prove himself worthy of a miracle, yet Lord you are always here close at hand, not far away. In communion, in confession, in a blessing, in prayer.

#### Tuesday

Today we take some time to remember the Annunciation. Of the words spoken by the Archangel St. Gabriel to Mary that she would bear the Christ Child. In fact we have the date of Christmas, December 25, because we simply wanted 9 months from today. The Annunciation is always in Lent. It reminds me You came from the glory of heaven and earth, O Lord, to pay the price for my sins. You willingly chose to die for me. Is there anything I could refuse You, O Lord? Can I ever stop to praise You? Lord give me the grace to stay with You always and never to take Your great love for granted.

#### Wednesday

(Dt 4: 1, 5-9) Lord when I follow Your law, I love You, for I say yes to You. Lord never let me believe the temptation that wants me to say I can be removed from Your will and love You. Keep before me Your words "If you love me you will keep My commandments". (Jn 14:15)

#### Thursday

(Jer 7: 23-28) Lord in Your love you gave me my will, so I may freely see You and follow You. But with this will I can also turn my back on you. Lord, I offer You my will. Keep me always with You and never let me turn my face from You.
