

FROM THE DESK OF FR. BONIFACE

Every Sunday we recall the Lord's resurrection, but I think that there is something special about celebrating the actual moment of the resurrection at Easter. The celebration of Easter is always so lively and happy and it recalls the key moments of our faith that we proclaim year round in our liturgies, homilies and talks.

Did you know that the Easter celebrations are not just what happens on Easter Sunday? No, rather they occur in three days, the Easter Triduum. The Church treats it as one long Mass, split up into 3 moments. The First is on Holy Thursday, the celebration of the Last Supper where Christ, after training His apostles for three years, ordaining them priests, gives them His last lesson in the washing of the feet, that the leaders are called to be Shepherds, living with, guiding the sheep and helping them along the journey.

Leadership in the Church is one of service to the Lord and others. And then of course, He gives us the Eucharist, the greatest of Sacraments, His very Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity with the words "Do this in memory of Me". This is not just a command, but a lesson for us. The more we do this (the Eucharist) the more we remember Jesus throughout the day and the more our hearts will be open to Him throughout the week. Yet Holy Thursday ends in a sense of foreboding, the altar is stripped of the linens, all is silent. Jesus has gone to His agony to take on the sins of the world and to await the crucifixion.

Good Friday, the cross, where He took up our sins and dies for them, taking the punishment meant for us, to save us is remembered. It is sombre as we stay with Mother Mary, with Ss John and Mary Magdalene at the foot of the cross, in love of a God who loved us so much that He suffered and died for us. I have always thought it very emotional because the greatest act of the service is not communion but the veneration of the cross where we kiss the author of our salvation and say a profound thank-you to the Lord as we promise never to leave Him as the crowds abandoned Him.

Then we wait at the tomb on the Vigil of Easter, reading all the prophecies of the Lord where He promised never to leave us, until we celebrate the resurrection with joy. The Gloria is sung, the bells are rung, we celebrate new life in baptism and confirmation for those seeking to enter the Church and we renew our own baptism.

In the fullness of joy we end our Lenten fast and the bridegroom is now here. Easter is the moment to rejoice. **Jesus is risen! Truly He has risen!!**

I have always felt that going through the triduum I have accomplished something special. We have walked with our Lord in joy, suffering and glory and, after all, is that not the point of our faith, to live with Him so as to reign with Him?
