

A LENTEN RETREAT FOR THE WEEK

Fourth Sunday of Lent:

(Jn 9: 1-41)

(Is 49: 8-15)

Lord, how hard it was for people to believe in You, even when they saw Your works. How hard it is to believe when You do or say things that do not conform to my established ways of acting and thinking. Lord I know that You are with me, there is no place I can go that You are not there. Lord You are not distant from me and every day You wish to show me something or talk to me. Lord, help me never to ignore Your words, give me an innocent and open heart to hear and accept Your words and a discerning mind to know what is truly from You, even if it is new and different for me. Lord, keep me always close to your church, a sheep of Your fold, a person particularly Your own.

Monday

(Is 65: 17-21) How I wish Your world of joy and life was here already. Lord as I hope for that day, by Your gracious abundance, Lord let me experience a little of it today and fill my heart with the light of Your joy and the serenity of Your peace.
