

# FAMILY OF FAITH CAMPAIGN

The Family of Faith campaign is nearing its conclusion at Holy Martyrs of Japan Parish. In addition to providing the resources to support our own parish needs, the campaign will help the Church of Toronto meet six critical priorities: providing financial support to parishes, developing leaders through Catholic formation and engagement, restoring St. Michael's Cathedral, investing in our youth, young adult ministry and campus chaplaincies, having a fund to aid existing church properties that need maintenance to keep them safe and secure, and helping to continue to build new churches through the archdiocese.

As of this week, 41 families have made pledges, averaging \$5,375 per gift. Thank you for your generosity!

The Family of Faith campaign will help our parish, too. For each dollar pledged, our parish will receive 25 cents. If we exceed our goal, we will keep 75 cents of every dollar above goal. With the parish share of the money raised, we plan to continue to pay down our mortgage, enrich our ministries, and look at improving our facilities like planning to add an additional bathroom at the back of the church.
