Consecration to the Truth

The Gospel takes us back to the last Supper again, and we hear the prayerful words of Jesus, which He directs to His heavenly Father. It is what some call "the high priestly prayer" of Jesus, because His words form a petition to His Father for the protection of those who are to carry His message to the world: "Holy Father, keep them in your name, which you have given me. Keep them from the evil one. Sanctify them in the truth." Jesus continues: "They are not of the world, even as I am not of the world. I have given them your word; and the world has hated them. I have sent them into the world. For their sake I consecrate myself, that they also may be consecrated in truth". (Jn 17:11, 15, 17, 16, 14, 18, 19)

This beautiful prayer is simple and meaningful. Our Lord, on the eve of His crucifixion and death, offers a fervent prayer for those who are to carry on in His footsteps. He knows that their preaching about the Good News will be rejected by many. The Apostles must have courage and strength in order to accept insult and persecution. St. Peter mentions this in one of his letters: "If you are reproached for the name of Christ, you are blessed, because the spirit of glory and of God rests upon you". (1 Pt. 4:14)

Countless souls from every walk of life have had to submit to insults and persecution because of their consecration to the truth. These have preferred to serve God, who is Truth.

The prayer of the "high priest" Jesus was made for the chosen Apostles and their successors. The divine petition has been granted over and over again to those who "are not of the world, that they also may be consecrated in truth." (Jn 17:16, 19) They had reason to rejoice as they suffered "for the name of Christ." (1 Pt 4:14), and they have passed on from generation to generation that great lesson of living in obedience to God. God is Truth itself, and one day our reward which He has placed in our hearts, and whatever sorrow may have come our way "will turn into joy." (Jn 16:20)


