

A LIGHT UNTO MY PATH

The meeting of Elijah with the widow Zarephath took place during a time of desperate drought in Israel. The prophet asked the old lady for some water and a crust of bread, and the widow responded that her condition was so dire that she had just enough for one more meal for herself and her son before they died. At which point Elijah asked her to make him a cake and bread! But the widow acceded to Elijah's request, giving even when she had next to nothing to give. And she found that her jar of flour did not go empty and her jug oil did not run dry. She and her son were able to survive the drought.

This is the presentation of one of the most fundamental truths in the spiritual life, namely, the law of the gift. This principle could be formulated as follows: your being increases in the measure that you give it away. Common sense dictates that our being increases in the measure that we hung on to the good that we desire: wealth, pleasure, power, honour, etc. But the truth is just the opposite, precisely because God is the source of being – and God is love. This means that our being is enhanced when we conform it to the divine manner of being, when we make a gift of what has been given to us.

Jesus knows the full worth of the poor widow who contributes to the Temple treasure "all she had, her whole livelihood." Although her alms financially amounted to almost nothing, she remained certain that God would be pleased with her sacrifice. For, more than her money, she sacrificed to God the last shreds of her self-sufficiency. Like the widow of Zarephath, she believed in a bounty beyond her meager means. "The jar of flour shall not go empty," for it has become the Bread of Life, Jesus, who provides for those who make their lives a total gift of self to him. In that action we discover our full worth. That is what Christ presents to the Father as He "appears before God on our behalf."
