Our Lord describes an intriguing situation. A man is about to set off on a long journey. He leaves his home – and his home probably includes a large farm and herds of animals in the hands of his servants. In fact, he puts them in charge. What is trust? To trust someone means much more than giving them a job to do. With trust, we hand ourselves over, as it were, to another person. We say, I will live and act on the assumption that you have my best interests at heart, that you will do what is best for me, that you will even put me before yourself, if the need arises.

What is distinctive about trust? Trust relates to the future; hence, it is not knowledge. Some of the synonyms for trust are confidence, reliance, and dependence; but the best one is faith. When we make a profound act of faith in God, we put ourselves into His hands, saying: I accept as true and life-giving all that you have revealed in Jesus Christ and recorded in the Holy Scriptures.
