FIRST SUNDAY OF ADVENT

"Stay awake! Do not let Him come suddenly and catch you asleep" (Mk. 13:33, 36). Today the Church begins her liturgical year with an exhortation to "be constantly on the watch." This sober and salutary thought is placed before us on this the First Sunday of Advent, to remind us to remain awake also in our preparation for the first coming of Jesus on earth in a little town called Bethlehem. 
