THIRTY SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

"The King of the universe will raise us up to an everlasting renewal of life" (2Mc.7:9) In the record book of Maccabees we are told about a mother and her seven children who were ready to die rather than deny their faith in the one true God. They did not fear death, because of their firm belief that God would raise them to a new life.

In today's Gospel Jesus corrects the misconception of the Sadducees and explains the true meaning of the Scriptures about the resurrection. The resurrection of the dead does not mean a return to or a continuation of the normal life of a person on earth. "The sons of this age marry and are given in marriage; but those who are accounted worthy to attain to that age and to the resurrection from the dead neither marry nor are given in marriage.... They are equal to angels and are sons of God"(Lk. 20:34-36). This does not mean that they will be without a body; otherwise, there would be not resurrection of the body. Their lives will be as that of "the sons of God," because they will participate in the life and glory of God. Our body after the resurrection will be like the glorious body of Christ. "The resurrected body will be spiritual, not ethereal or subtile, but the same body. The spiritual body does not mean that it is made of spirit, but a body penetrated by the spirit, moved by the spirit perfectly, and at the service of the spirit" (F. Silvestrini-Comment to the Festive Lectionary, Vol. 13, p180)

The Christian's resurrection starts here on earth. It begins with his spiritual resurrection in Baptism: Once dead to sin, we are restored to grace and to the life of God. When someone near and dear to us dies, the Christian who believes in the resurrection should remember our sadness turns to joy. The mortal body will one day be immortal and there will be no more suffering. "For we must all appear before the judgement seat of Christ, so that each one may receive good or evil, according to what he has done in body".
