

FROM THE DESK OF FR. BONIFACE



On this weekend we are always reminded to give thanks for what we have. But I don't think we are an un-thankful people. I believe that many of us have good things given to us even amidst difficult ones: our family, gifts to use to provide for them, food and clean water and a country that, despite our political dispositions, does provide for us in its resources, stability and liberties very well, compared to many lands around our world. We have ultimately a God who loves us and we have the privilege of knowing that love, and His grace in our world, through the gift of the Church He gave us.

But perhaps because they are always there we have come to expect these things. Perhaps this is why we are shocked when they may not always be there. Perhaps we may even think of them as rights owed us and not part of God's gifts to us. So it is a good idea, always to be "practically thankful". What does it mean to be "practically thankful"? Include a prayer of thanksgiving in our everyday prayers. Go up to a friend or family member and say "I like when you are around, I like spending time with you". It may make us feel vulnerable and, yes, maybe we don't like to admit we need others, that we are self-sufficient, perfect within ourselves. But we are not.

I have always found that admitting my need for others has makes me relish them more, be less argumentative with them and be more attentive to their needs. Being grateful about the goods of the earth has made me think more carefully about choices I have made about not being wasteful with the materials I have, like food. It reminds me that my life can't be about me but about others, ultimately about God, for we exist to love Him and manifest His love to the world. We must never be complacent with the tragedies caused by being self-absorbed: anger, indifference that deflates us and sends us constantly searching for self-fulfillment for the self can never fulfill itself. It can be fulfilled only by God.

It's amazing what a simple phrase like "Thank You" can do for us.
