TWENTY EIGHTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Whose Interests come first - God or Mine?

The royal wedding banquet is one of the ways Jesus described the Kingdom of God. It is something we can imagine as being majestic, beautiful, as the feast of all feasts-but most importantly, we are not bystanders or guests, but we are all members of Christ's body!

So why does the parable seem to focus on an angry king? There are two stories here: the first one deals with the original guests — the king gives the invite well in advance to help them prepare, but they put their own interests above the king's. The king is justifiably angry because they openly refuse Christ, which can have consequences... This is an invitation we cannot refuse! The second part of the story deals with the guests who would normally not be invited-but are invited anyway. This is certainly an invitation of grace-undeserved, unmerited favor and kindness! But this invitation also contains a warning for those who refuse it or who approach the wedding feat unworthily. God's grace is a free gift, but it is also an awesome responsibility.

God invites each of us as his friends to his heavenly banquet that we may celebrate with him and share in his joy. Are you ready to feast at the Lord's banquet table?

COMMUNION AND CONFIRMATION SACRAMENTS

Grades two and seven are milestone years in the eyes of the Catholic Church. For the grade two's it is a spiritual time where we prepare our children for the Sacrament of Reconciliation and Communion and for the grade seven's, a completion of the initiation of the faith with the Sacrament of Confirmation. Each sacrament a blessed gift from God.

Letters regarding these sacraments have be made available at the back of the Church on the cabinet. The First Communion Letter is yellow and Confirmation Letters are green. The children in grade two and seven in our five Catholic schools received these letters.
