

WHAT IS THE MASS?

In our spiritual life, the Mass is the single most important activity that any of us ever can participate in. In the Mass the whole Church offers in union with Christ the supreme act of worship. Jesus Christ, as God and man,

redeemed us from our sins by offering Himself to His Father as a worthy and acceptable sacrifice on the cross, dying in reparation for the sins of everyone. Through the Sacrament of Baptism, Christ enables us to enter into His left so that they are no longer separated from God but share in His Divine life by sharing in Christ's life. The Holy Mass, in the liturgy of the Eucharist, is a representation of Christ's passion and death. Christ offered Himself on the cross as both God and man. Since God acts in eternity, His actions are not limited to time and space. So just as what appeared to be bread and wine to the Apostles at the Last Supper on the night before Christ died was in truth as He said His Body and Blood offered for the Redemption of all, the Eucharist at the Mass appears as bread and wine but is truly the very same Body and Blood of Christ that underwent his passion and crucifixion. The Sacrifice at every single Mass is the exact same Sacrifice and not a repetition. Christ's sacrifice happened only once, and at Mass, the Priest, who represents Christ, offers that same sacrifice. Be eating as Christ commanded, His Body, and drinking His Blood, the baptized are brought more fully into union with Him and enter more fully into His left and grace so that they we may live the Gospel that He taught and continues to teach through His Church.

LET A CHILD HAVE FAITH IN YOU

Each year in the Catholic community, there are hundreds of children that need to leave their family home and be placed in foster care. At any given time, there are more than 1,100 children and youth unable to live with their parents due to parental illness, abandonment, child abuse or neglect. The Catholic Children's Aid Society of Toronto depends on loving foster families to provide safe and nurturing homes for these vulnerable children and youth.

Sadly, there are not enough foster homes to accommodate these children in the Greater Toronto area. In the words of Archbishop Thomas Collins: "I strongly believe that more Catholic families would be open to caring for foster children if they were aware of this urgent need for foster homes. I am inviting you to seriously consider fostering, and reflect on the benefit the experience can bring to your family and vulnerable children in the community."

COMMUNICATION to our FAITH COMMUNITY regarding the H1N1 FLU VIRUS

The Sign of Peace is an important part of our liturgical celebration. The usual custom is to express the Sign of Peace by shaking hands. It may, however, be preferable, especially in our present circumstances, to use another gesture, for example, by bowing and perhaps saying "Peace be with you". A full letter (pink copies) from the Archdiocese can be found at the back of the Church along with sanitization gel.


