THIRTIETH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

SITTING WITH SCRIPTURE

The Gospel recalls something that we are all happy to hear, namely, the words of Jesus on the greatest commandment. "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind." This is the great and first commandment. And a second is like it. You shall love your neighbor as yourself. On these two commandments depend all the law and the prophets. Love God above all things, and love your neighbor for the love of God. This is the essence of our holy religion; this is the Good News of Jesus the Messiah, which the Church never stops preaching and proclaiming. The answer which Jesus gave was not exactly what the Pharisee expected. Jesus made all ten commandments equally great and important, because, as a whole, all ten go to make up the great commandment of love. Love is in each and every one of the ten commandments. Hence, we cannot say that one commandment is greater than any of the others; but that all ten commandments are equally great because love is behind each and every one of them. To say that we love God and then deliberately or nonchalantly violate a commandment which we might consider of little importance is to interpret our Lord's words in a way which He never intended. Our Lord made all ten commandments great. He summed up the first three commandments as one commandment - love of God which they do express. And He grouped the next seven under a second commandment - love of neighbor - which is found in them. The love of God takes precedence, and it has no limits, because it includes our heart, our soul, and our mind. St. Francis de Sales puts it this way: "The true measure of our love for God is to love Him without measure." And another St. Francis, the one from Assisi, expressed his measureless love of God by telling Him day and night: "My God and my All!"
