SPIRITUAL BLINDNESS

The Gospel places before us a blind beggar by the name of Bartimaeus. He was sitting by the roadside and heard that Jesus of Nazareth was passing by. The blind man began to call out "Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!" He was told to keep quiet, but he shouted all the louder, "Son of David, have mercy on me!" Jesus heard the man's plea and said "What do you want me to do for you?" "Master" the blind man said, "let me receive my sight" And Jesus said to him, "Go your way; your faith has made you well" (Mt 10:47, 48, 51-52). His sight was restored immediately, and, instead of going away, he followed Jesus up the road. Though very poor, his feeling of gratitude was so deep that he was willing to do whatever Jesus might ask him to do.

Our Lord helped to relieve the bodily afflictions and sufferings of many, and He also cured sicknesses of the soul. The primary purpose of His coming on earth was to restore heath to man's soul, as He also gave to Bartimaeus. Some are spiritually blind from birth, because of parents who were neglectful in their religious obligations. Others became spiritually blind later on in life, because of their evil ways which they refuse to give up. Some of these who are spiritually blind would be willing to seek a cure, provided some changes were made in the ten commandments!

The blind beggar found favour because he sought help in all sincerity. "Jesus, Son of David, have pity on me!" Those who are spiritually blind can also obtain a cure, if they seek it in all sincerity: "Jesus, Son of David, have pity on me!"

Whether we are spiritually blind or not, it is always good spiritual therapy to constantly implore God's mercy, forgiveness, and love with the prayer, "*My Jesus, mercy!*" These are three simple words which everyone can remember and use.
