

AROUND THE ALTAR OF THE LORD



<u>THE SANCTUARY – THE ALTAR,</u> <u>AMBO and CHAIR</u>

The sanctuary is the place where the altar stands, where the word of God is proclaimed, and where the priest, the deacon, and the other ministers exercise

their offices (GIRM 295 - General Instructions to the Roman Missile). The three principle objects within the sanctuary are the Altar, Ambo (lectern), and Chair (of the priest), and it is from these three that the priest performs Christ's office as Priest, Prophet and King in the liturgy. From the Chair, the priest acts as king and his chair signifies "his presiding over the gathering and of directing prayer" (GIRM 310 - General Instructions to the Roman Missile). It is set in a place of prominence in the sanctuary. The readings and the Gospel are proclaimed from the Ambo whish is normally placed on the opposite side of the altar from the priest's chair. The Ambo's importance arises from the Word of God that is proclaimed from it and the priest's exercise of Christ's prophetic office, preaching the Word of God and instructing the faithful. The Altar holds the central place in the sanctuary. As the table upon which the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass is offered, the altar is a sacred Before it is used for the first time, the bishop object. consecrates it with holy oils and places within it relics of the saints, traditionally martyrs though other saints are allowable. The practice of offering the Sacrifice of the Mass over the bodies of those who have died for the faith continues from the very early days of the Church when martyrs' tombs served as altars. The practice reminds us that the Sacrifice offered on the altar is offered in union with those who are already with God, especially those who, like Christ, died for the faith that He taught. It is important to remember that at the altar the priest acts as Christ Himself. Christ acts through the priest offering the sacrifice of Himself to God the Father and enabling members of the Church on earth to participate in the Sacrifice made present in the Eucharist that He offered once on the Cross.

Introduction to the Holy Mass

On a personal note, when I re-read these words. I was struck by the awesome mystery of my vocation. I do not exercise it because I am worthy to act in Persona Christi, (in the person of Christ). But Christ, nonetheless according to His own will, called me to this vocation, and unworthy as I am to be His voice and hands to offer the sacrifice of the Mass on behalf of His people. These offices of priest, prophet and king are Christ's offices which in all humility and joy I have but a part. Please pray for me that I may always be a good and worthy priest as I pray for you every time I approach the altar.
