## SITTING WITH SCRIPTURE

Some people imagine humility to be a weakness. Humility receives a terrible reputation and becomes identified with things it is not. Some people see humility as a kind of constant self-denigration by which we feel that we are supposed to deny our abilities and powers, those special gifts God has given to every one of us. That is really a rejection of the Creator's gifts to each of us that tragically passes for "humility."

There is also a phony humility that becomes a disguise for arrogance, when a person uses the language of humility as a way of extracting more applause. We all know how it goes: "You did a great job." "No, it wasn't that great." "No, it was really terrific." "No, it was nothing." It's phony humility. Real humility is about truth, truth about ourselves, our soul and our need of God's grace. Humility is, first of all, clarity and honesty about ourselves, the gifts and talents we have and, more importantly, about the gifts we don't have, about our limitations.

The first reading from the Old Testament Book of Sirach teaches us to live our life with this humility, that is, without pretense.

Finally, humility is not just truth about ourselves or the state of our soul but also about our need of God's grace.

The Lord is speaking to those who had an inflated sense of their own self-righteousness and to those who think they are self-made Christians. The truth is we need God's grace. Only the Lord can call us higher to stronger spiritual life and strength. When a person tries to claim a deeper spirituality than he or she really has, that is, when we think we can do everything by ourselves, exalting ourselves and we stop going to God and we fall. But when our pretense is gone, then we are wide open to God's grace and His call to come higher to real spiritual growth.

Humility, the virtue of truth about ourselves, our soul and our need of God's grace, doesn't keep us from fooling God because we can't fool God. Humility keeps us from fooling ourselves.

## **Pre-Authorized Giving**

My Mom once said "money can't buy you the things that are most important, but boy do you still need it".

If you looked around at Mass this Sunday you noticed that in the summer months people take the opportunity to go on vacation and enjoy the weather. All good things. I myself will be taking advantage of this in August. But without intending it, what that does is create a boom and bust cycle in our finances. We do well from October to June and struggle July through September.

However, I might ask that you think about Pre-Authorized Giving. You can sign up for this in the Parish Office. This is a system where money is automatically taken from your account and transferred to the Parish. You obviously set your own amount and it appears on your statement. It is taken only for regular offerings (no money is removed for second collections). Even when you go on vacation, your donation is made and it allows for an even cash flow for the year. Some people say "well when I am at Mass and it's time for the collection, I feel compelled to put something in". Many people do. Those on Pre-Authorized Giving still get envelopes and simple put a blank one in, writing on the envelope PAG.

## AN ANGEL IS COMING

If you have been over at our cemetery since the expansion, you have noticed at the end of the road is a turn-around. You will notice rods sticking out of the center. It has always been the desire when the cemetery was expanded not only to make this a place to lav our loved ones to rest, but to remind those who visit that our true home is in heaven and that in Christ there is no death. We on earth are members of Christ's body and the society of the Church as were our loved ones, and, as they still are, nothing separates those bound in Christ. There is no veil that completely cuts us off from them. While our loved ones are never far away, in Christ there is still a mystical union connecting all of us. This is why when we pray for them and in prayer speak to them, we can still, at times, feel them close to us, or indeed they are Christ Himself revealed. As quoted when he said "God the Father is the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob" (Mt. 22:32), not he was the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. He never speaks of the deceased in the past tense. They are with us. I have been discussing with the Cemetery Board how to represent this in a way that also honours our blessed dead buried at the cemetery. We have decided on a statue of an angel. You can see a picture of it at the back of the Church on the bulletin board.

Keeping to the custom, there will be space on the sides and back of the statue for those who wish a special remembrance of family members. The front of the statue will contain words of universal remembrance. The donation for this is \$200.00. It will be shown on your tax receipt next January. Due to space limitations, and, so as to offer this option to as many people as possible, we are asking that only one name be given per donation, (a maximum of 18 characters including spaces). There is room for about 150 names on the base. If you would like to add the name of a loved one, please contact the office at 905-775-2065.
