"CLEANSING THE INSIDE OF THE CUP"

The Second Reading consists of verses taken from the Letter of St. James. The apostle wants the people in general to be doers of the word, and not mere listeners. "Be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves" (Jas. 1:22). We become doers of the word if we look after the needs of orphans and widows, and if we keep ourselves "unspotted by the world." This makes for pure worship before our God and Father.

In the Gospel today, our Lord has something to say on this same subject: "This people honors me with their lips, but their heart is far from me; in vain do they worship me" (Mk 7:6-7). Jesus condemns the human heart that is full of all that is evil. "For from within, out of the heart of man, come evil thoughts, fornication, theft, murder, adultery, coveting wickedness, deceit, licentiousness, envy, slander, pride, foolishness" (Mk. 7:21-22). The law of God and its observance do not depend on mere external actions and customs, but on clear understanding and intimate conviction. The Pharisees, who were constantly watching Jesus and His disciples, were scrupulous about washing their hands and following other human traditions.

We are exhorted by Jesus to have clean thoughts, to speak words that edify, and to perform actions that will prove to others that we really love them as ourselves, that they are our brothers and sisters. We must avoid mere lip service. The person that really loves God will show to the world that the hand of God is operating through him. Moses and Jesus, and also St. James in today's reading, are appealing to man's loyalty and obedience. These things must come, not from external compliance with the doings and customs, but from the heart of a person who fully understands and obeys his God.


