SITTING WITH SCRIPTURE

This is the understanding that the Almighty has with freedom, the secret of which is that the stronger the power of grace, the more freely freedom belongs to itself. He makes no rigid demands. His love is eternally renewed, guided by a Father's constant care for his children. God accompanies everything that happens, cooperating with human freedom. This is the ineffable mystery of his patience, which is possible only because he is the truly living God and the almighty living God...

The fact is that the more profoundly a person has become a Christian, the more alive will be his concern to do the will of God and the more aware he will be that this will is the most precious, and the most gentle, and the most powerful thing in the world. Any the more he realizes his own sinfulness , the more he will turn to the Lord of the world and pray that he may cherish and fulfill that high purpose on which the meaning of everything depends. At the same time, he will grow more confident that the will of God will be done and will triumph over all the powers of evil.

The Christian carries deep within him the fear that he may decline from God's holy will; the anxiety that he may deface the beauty of his will, that he may lose sight of his irretrievable purpose. And so he prays for the patience of God. Yet he tells himself that it is impossible for God's will to be lost. Sin appeared to have destroyed God's will for the world, but it was followed by the tremendous fact of redemption. The creation that had been destroyed was taken up onto the hope of a "new heaven and a new earth".

But the Christian may not deduce safe guarantees from this. In the constant, absorbing care that God's will may be done, he must persevere and watch and work.
