

SITTING WITH SCRIPTURE

"Tax collectors and prostitutes are entering the kingdom of God". Why? Because when they encountered Jesus Christ, who "did not regard equality with God something to be grasped", they found in Him what they formerly had been looking for in sin. And that is what made it easy for them to leave behind their grasping ways and obey the one who Himself became "obedient to the point of death." If someone "turns from wickedness and does what is right and just, he shall surely live, he shall not die", as we hear in the first reading. Because it means that that person has found Jesus Christ who is infinitely more attractive than even the most powerful allure of evil. Today's parable may challenge us. We all have said yes to the Lord, but as Jesus says "blessed are they who hear the word of God and keep it." (Lk 11:28). It calls us to examine all of our life for authenticity, sincerity and innocence of heart.
