THE SACRED LITURGY THIS WEEK

Monday January 9, *The Baptism of the Lord.* *In the Eastern Church this feast is called Theophany because at the baptism of Christ in the River Jordan God appeared in 3 persons. Christ did not need the baptism of John. Although He appeared in the "substance of our flesh" and was recognized "outwardly like unto ourselves," He was absolutely sinless and impeccable. He conferred upon the water the power of the true Baptism which would remove all the sins of the world: "Behold the Lamb of God, behold Him Who takes away the sin of the world." Many of the incidents which accompanied Christ's baptism are symbolical of what happened at our Baptism. At Christ's baptism the Holy Spirit descended upon Him; at our Baptism the Trinity took its abode in our soul. At His baptism Christ was proclaimed the "Beloved Son" of the Father; at our Baptism we become the adopted sons of God. At Christ's baptism the heavens were opened; at our Baptism heaven was opened to us. At His baptism Jesus prayed; after our Baptism we must pray to avoid actual sin.*

Thursday January 12th, *St. Marguerite Bourgeoys, (1620-1800)* *was born the 6th of 12 children in France on Good Friday. She felt inspired to join the religious life and agreed to go to Canada to educate French and Native children in a settlement in the French colonies that would eventually become Montreal. In 1658, in a stable which had been given to her by the governor for her use, she opened the first school in Montreal. Convinced of the importance of the family in the building of this new country, and perceiving the significance of the role to be exercised by women, she devoted herself to the task of educating girls. She visited France several times to recruit young women to come and help her educate. She initiated a school system and a network of social services which gradually extended through the whole country, Her deep faith gave her the courage & tenacity to endure Iroquois attacks, a fire that destroyed her small village & plagues on the ships to and from France. She became known as "Mother of the Colony".*

THE YOUNG MESSIAH IS REVEALED AS THE LIGHT OF THE NATIONS

Epiphany means manifestation and celebrates "the revelation of God in his Son, as human, in Jesus Christ". It celebrates the manifestation of our Lord to the whole world after being made known to the shepherds of Bethlehem and his being revealed to the Magi who have come from the East to adore Him. Epiphany celebrates the 12th day of Christmas, and marks the official end to the festive season for many Christians. "The Lord and ruler is coming; kingship is his, and government and power." With these words the Church proclaims that this feast brings to a perfect fulfillment all the purposes of Advent.

Three mysteries are encompassed in this solemnity: the adoration of the Christ Child by the Magi, the Baptism of Christ and the wedding feast at Cana. The link is not hard to see. The Magi's homage shows divinity of this child-king who is to die for his people. Jesus' baptism in the Jordan reveals a glimpse of God's inner life as Trinity. And the wedding feast of Cana reveals the divine power at work in the middle of everyday life, at a wedding reception

Christian tradition has ever seen in the Magi the first fruits of the Gentiles; they lead in their wake all the peoples of the earth, and thus the Epiphany is an affirmation of universal salvation. St. Leo brings out this point admirably in a sermon, in which he shows in the adoration of the Magi the beginnings of Christian faith, the time when the great mass of the heathen sets off to follow the star which summons it to seek its Saviour. In Spain, each one of the Magi is supposed to represent one different continent, Europe (Melchior), Asia (Caspar) and Africa (Balthasar).

The date of Epiphany, is January 6, however, in most countries, including Canada, the celebration of Epiphany is transferred to the Sunday that falls between January 2 and January 8 (inclusive). The six Sundays which follow Epiphany are known as the time of manifestation.


