HEARING ASSISTANCE: MOBILE CONNECT

The new wifi/bluetooth hearing assistance system is now active in the church. It involves:

- Downloading the Sennheiser "MobileConnect" app to your phone.
- 2. Using your phone to join the "Hearing_ Assist" WIFI network; password: LetMeHear1!
- 3. Open the MobileConnect app, and choose the "St Basil Hearing Assist" channel.
- 4. You can listen to the channel directly on your phone, or you can connect your phone to a bluetooth device such as hearing aids or earbuds.

Mothers are welcome to nurse their children in church or provide them snacks as needed. If you need to, feel free to walk with your child in the back of the church or in the hallway off the side aisle.







FINANCIAL REPORT & GIVING OPTIONS

In July, we provided you with our financial report, which outlined our revenue and expenses for the last two fiscal years. As we shared, we continue to be in a strong financial position but want to ensure that our parish income can continue to keep pace with need and inflation.

Our offertory (weekly Sunday collection) is our main source of funding and has not increased over the last three years. Your offertory funds allow us to plan ahead and be responsive to the Spirit at work in our community and offer creative programs that enrich the life and faith of our parishioners.

We ask all parishioners to prayerfully consider starting to give to the offertory on a regular basis or increasing your weekly giving as you are able. Even a 10% increase, or \$5 more per week will make an enormous difference to our parish and our impact.

There are three tax-deductible ways to give:

- Weekly Sunday Envelopes
- **Pre-Authorized Giving (PAG)** automatic monthly debits from your bank account
- Credit Card Payment (either online via CanadaHelps, or via machines we will procure this year). Please note: we are charged a processing fee by these platforms for each credit card payment, which is deducted from your donation.

If you are not yet a registered parishioner, please register (online or via our paper form) to be set up with envelopes or PAG. If you are already registered, please contact our office for your envelopes or to sign up for or make changes to your PAG.

We thank you for your generosity in support of our parish's initiatives. Please continue to keep our community in your prayers as we seek to serve the Lord in our neighbourhood.

BECOMING CATHOLIC: RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS (RCIA)

Consider joining us for the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA), a journey of exploration, prayer, reflection, study, and conversation that leads to full Christian initiation in the Roman Catholic community through the Sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist, and Confirmation at the Easter Vigil. This program serves adults including:

- Those who have never been baptized
- Those baptized in another Christian denomination

Our program includes weekly meetings typically held on Wednesday nights from October through May, and all participants receive support from parishioners in their journey of faith.


