#### LISTENING TO INDIGENOUS VOICES

All are welcome to join us for a 4-part (Feb 16, Mar 16, Apr 20) series of listening and sharing as we work through the Dialogue Guide: Listening to Indigenous Voices. Each evening will begin with dinner at 5:30, followed by a brief introduction by Elder Bob Philips along with an understanding of how sharing circles work. Much of the evening will be spent in sharing circles and we'll conclude with a larger group Q and A period.

## CATECHESIS AND SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION

#### ST. BASIL'S ELEVATOR: OUT OF SERVICE (FEB & MAR)

From approximately February 6 until April 1, the elevator will be out of service as it is being modernised. We are concerned with how this will affect persons who depend on the elevator to access the church for Mass and who would be unable, with assistance, to walk up and down the 6 steps next to the elevator. We are exploring ways that we might best serve those persons who are affected during this disruption to facilitate their continued participation in the life of the parish. We are open to any ideas that you might have.

One possibility we are exploring is to move one (1) of the Sunday Masses (probably the 12pm Sunday Mass) to the chapel at the Cardinal Flahiff Basilian Centre (CFBC), which has elevator access. The CFBC chapel is located at 95 St. Joseph St., across the street from St. Basil's. There is parking near the elevator entrance, along the building's west side. Other possibilities include enhancing our ministry of bringing Holy Communion to the homes of those affected if they are unable to come in person.
