Divina Eloquia - Patristic Conceptions of Martyrdom and Their Relevance Today presented by Dr. Katherine E. Milco. All are invited to join on January 30th at 6:30 p.m. for this free talk. Dr. Milco is the Assistant Professor of Classics and Early Christian Studies at Sacred Heart Seminary and School of Theology in Wisconsin.
