

12PM SUNDAY MASS – TEMPORARY LOCATION CHANGE

The elevator at St. Basil's will be out of service from Monday, February 5 until Saturday, April I. Beginning Sunday, February 12, the 12:00pm Sunday Mass will be relocated to the Cardinal Flahiff Basilian Centre (CFBC) chapel, which is accessible for people with disabilities. The final Sunday we expect to be celebrating the 12:00pm Mass at the CFBC chapel will be March 26, though this date could change depending on the progress of the elevator project.

The CFBC chapel is located at 95 St. Joseph St. (across the street from St. Basil's Church). It is accessible through the glassed-in elevator lobby at the northwest corner of the building (near Kelly Library) or through the main entrance in the middle of the building. The chapel will be accessible through the elevator or main entrance starting at 11:30am each Sunday. Parking is available along the west side of the CFBC in addition to parallel parking on both sides of St. Joseph Street. St. Basil's hospitality ministers will be assisting people who need help finding the CFBC chapel.

While the elevator is out of service, there will NOT be a 12:00pm Mass celebrated in St. Basil's Church. However, none of the other weekend Masses (i.e., Saturday 5:00pm and Sunday 9:00am, 10:30am, and 4:30pm) or weekday Masses (i.e., 7:30am and 12:10pm) will be affected; they will continue to be celebrated in St. Basil's Church.
