# HEARING ASSISTANCE: MOBILE CONNECT

The new wifi/bluetooth hearing assistance system is now active in the church. It involves:

- Downloading the Sennheiser "MobileConnect" app to your phone.
- 2. Using your phone to join the "Hearing\_ Assist" WIFI network; password: LetMeHear1!
- 3. Open the MobileConnect app, and choose the "St Basil Hearing Assist" channel.
- 4. You can listen to the channel directly on your phone, or you can connect your phone to a bluetooth device such as hearing aids or earbuds.

# DIPLOMA IN INTERFAITH DIALOGUE

The Diploma in Interfaith Dialogue from Continuing Education at the University of St. Michael's College in the University of Toronto is a 10-course program designed to help answer the question, "what could be possible if we understood each other better?" You'll learn communication skills to help navigate difference, and will learn about the beliefs, practices, cultures, and traditions of world faiths.

Courses are online & in-person, and you can complete the Diploma fully online if you want/need to. Every course is only \$150, and to enroll, just pick a class & sign up, there is no application process. Take one or all of the courses offered, it's totally up to you.

#### New! Faith & Food Course

Faith can inform what we eat in meaningful ways: what we eat where and when, and how and who we eat it with can all be important ways of communicating our values and beliefs, and how we relate to each other within our communities. From how we use food in celebrating holidays to how we bless it around the table to the role of religious and cultural laws and global histories that shape what's on our plates, food plays a key role in how we can learn about and experience each other's faith traditions.

In this course, learners will visit a new place of worship each week, including St. Basil's, and prepare and share a meal together with the host congregation. In this way, we will learn about and experience each other's cultures and flavours, receive hospitality, explore each other's spaces, and hear about the ways that faith and fellowship are practiced across Toronto.


