I returned home with these words of the hymn in my heart, to find an email from JoAnn, inviting me to share my reflections on the readings of this Sunday. I was moved as I read the Second letter of Paul to Timothy (2.8-13):


"The saying is sure: If we have died with him, we shall also live with him...he remains faithful - for he cannot deny himself."


