

All are invited to join for a special event happening the evening of Friday, November 10 at the Newman Centre. It's the inaugural Toronto seminar of CAPP-Canada (*Centesimus Annus Pro Pontifice*), the Canadian arm of a Vatican foundation founded by Pope John Paul II to spread the Church's social doctrine as a tool for the transformation of society.

The CAPP-Canada seminar is focused on the theme of moral courage in leadership. What is the role of moral courage in our vocations as leaders in our various professions, institutional contexts, and civic commitments? They'll be examining the virtue of courage through the lives of two extraordinary Blesseds, Clemens August Graf Von Galen and Franz Jagerstatter. One was bishop of Munster, Germany and defied Hitler during the darkest days of the Nazi reign. The other was a conscientious objector who refused to participate in Hitler's war machine. They're also hosting Father Daniel Utrecht, Von Galen's English language biographer, for a talk on the bravery of this incredible bishop.
