



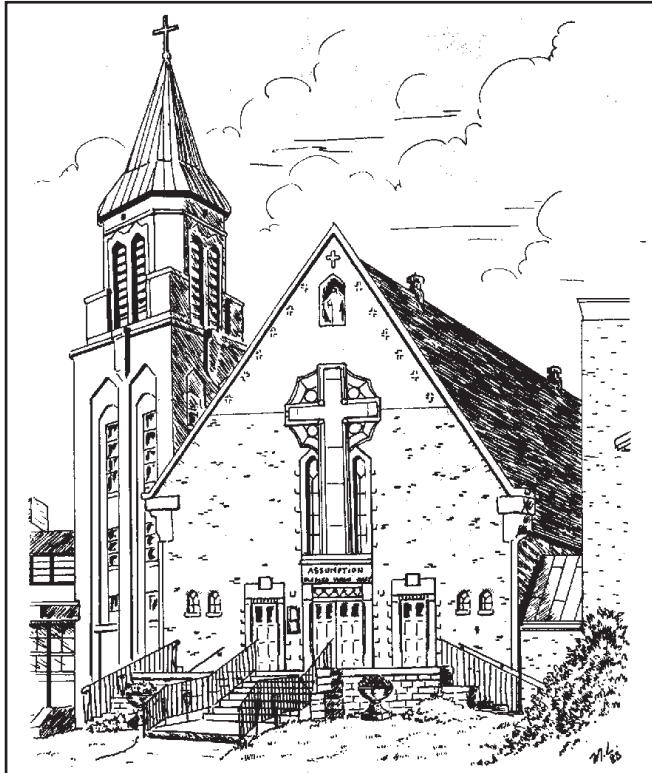

PASTORAL & SACRAMENTAL CARE

Baptism: Please call the Parish Office to make an appointment to register your child for Baptism and to discuss all the requirements. If you belong to another parish, a letter of permission from your pastor is required. If you are not a parishioner of any parish, you must register and attend Mass regularly, and there is a three-month waiting period before your child can be baptized.

Confessions: Weekdays, after the 8 am morning Mass (approach the priest); First Fridays - 8:45 am to 9:15 am; First Saturdays - 9:30 am to 10:00 am, 3:30 pm to 4:00 pm (by appointment) Every Sunday - 11:30 am to 12noon

Marriages: One of the couples must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months and attend Mass here regularly. Please make arrangements at least six months before the wedding date. Marriage Preparation Course required.

Sacrament of the Sick & Communion for Shut-ins: Please contact the Parish Office

Funerals: Arrangements should be made firstly with the church, and then with the funeral director to insure proper Christian burial Assisted by the Bereavement Ministry

Youth Ministry: Every 1st Saturday of the month, 30 to 45 min. session (after the 4 pm Mass) at Carlo Acutis Hall.

ATTENTION

Due to security concerns following the recent incidents involving misplaced keys and unauthorized duplication of access keys, **the Parish has decided to change the door locks at the Church's entrances.**

Popes' reflections on the intimate relationship Body and Blood of Jesus and the Sacred Heart

Pope Leo XIV called Christ's Body and Blood in the Eucharist "**a sacrifice of love for the salvation of the world,**" highlighting the Eucharist's transformative power in the lives of the faithful.

Pope Francis' encyclical "**Dilexit nos**" also speaks of the Sacred Heart as the source of Christ's infinite love, urging the Church and the faithful to embody this love in their daily lives. Both pontiffs encourage deeper reflection on the love of Christ, as represented in His Sacred Heart, which is essential for authentic devotion and the renewal of the Church's mission.

Pope Benedict XVI's reflections on the Solemnity of the Sacred Body and Blood of Christ emphasize the intimate connection between the Eucharist and the Sacred Heart draws upon **Pius XII's Haurietis Aquas** and the Gospels to illustrate the devotion to the Sacred Heart as a crucial image of Christianity's center. The devotion to the Sacred Heart is seen as a way to express the love of God revealed in Jesus Christ, particularly through the Eucharist, the divine institution of the Eucharist, and the sending of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles and upon us. The Pope's theology of the heart is summarized in the book **Jesus of Nazareth**, where it is described as the organ for seeing God and a way of speaking about the fully integrated person.

Pope John Paul II emphasizes that the body can make visible what is invisible, including the spiritual and the divine. This teaching is rooted in the belief that the human body reveals God, and it plays a crucial role in the mystery of the Sacred Heart. His teachings on the body and blood of Jesus are deeply intertwined with the concept of the Sacred Heart, which is central to the Catholic Church's understanding of the Incarnation and the mystery of the divine.
