Stewards Listen

"I am the good shepherd...and I lay down my life for the sheep...and they will heed my voice." - JOHN 10:14-16

When you pray, do you only ask Jesus for the things that you want? Do you ever ask Jesus what He wants from his Steward? How do you listen for His response? Many times, Jesus responds in "quiet whispers" that are not so obvious. So, take time every day, in silence, to actively listen for His voice.

Resurrection Story:

In the midst of our prayers for peace in the Middle East, esp. Gaza, our hearts go out to the people of Gaza. Here is (part) of a message from parish priest of Holy Family Parish, Gaza ...

Spring is here. And even so, we cannot cover the sun with our hands or pretend thinking that the reality in Gaza is fine. No, things are not fine; they are very bad, extremely bad! But we, as believers in the Risen Lord, cannot cover that other Sun either, which is Jesus Christ returned from the dead.

In Gaza, and thanks to the Easter celebrations, we know that Christ has returned risen there. With hearts full of the joy of the Resurrection, and even amidst tribulation, our Catholic community in Gaza wishes you a happy Easter and thanks you for so many prayers and support.

Easter reality, resurrection understood:

Daily Quote from the Early Church Fathers: He descended so that we might ascend, by Augustine of Hippo, 354-430 A.D.

"Spiritual birth happens when human beings, being earthly, become heavenly. And this can only happen when they are made members of me. So that he may ascend who descended, since no one ascends who did not descend. Therefore, everyone who needs to be changed and raised must meet together in a union with Christ so that the Christ who descended may ascend, considering his body (that is to say, his church)6 as nothing other than himself."
