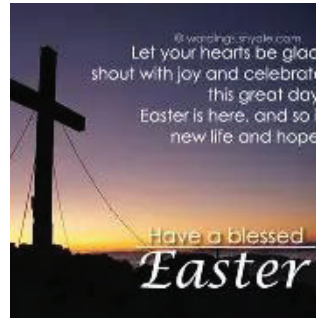

Caring Stewards

“This man God raised on the third day and granted that he be visible, not to all the people, but to us, the witnesses chosen by God in advance, who ate and drank with him after he rose from the dead.”

Acts 10:40-41

The first disciples were people who witnessed the risen Christ in the flesh. The author of Acts emphasizes that they ate and drank with the risen Christ. How we take care of each other "in this life" is an important part of our spiritual life. Stewardship is not about having pious thoughts, but about making life better for others in the flesh.

Easter a time for Sacraments:

It has been reported by Catholic Register... Over 20,000 catechumens in France are expected to be baptized during the Easter Vigil, marking a 20% increase compared to baptisms in 2025. "While we have long sensed the difficulty—if not the inability—of our consumer society to respond to the deepest aspirations of the human person, we are nevertheless struck by the suddenness and the scale of the thirst for God that is being expressed today," French Archbishop de Germay wrote. Here at St Augustine parish this has been year of the lowest numbers of Sacraments celebrated this past year... with only one catechumen and very few Baptisms of infants this past year. We are happy to have St Elizabeth parish with nine candidates for Confirmation to join our 13 candidates for June 13. Interesting times indeed!

How is Easter received today?

In a world where war and violence, skepticism and secularism abound ... how so many are far away from such a message of promise this DAY brings. This is the DAY the Lord has made! Do you receive the news of Jesus' resurrection with skepticism and doubt or with faith and joyful wonderment? On Sunday morning the women who had witnessed Jesus death on the cross went to the tomb to pay their last tribute to a dead body. The disciples thought that everything had finished in tragedy. Neither were ready to see an empty tomb and hear the angel's message, "Why do you seek the living among the dead? Is it any small wonder that it was the women, rather than the apostles, who first witnessed the empty tomb and the resurrected Lord?
