#### PASTOR'S DESK

Our history continues: Another pivotal moment which brought about change and challenge with continuing to build our Christian Community was in the early 1980's when the Augustinians left the parish and Ottawa. It was an end of era. An end to the leadership and the vision of the Augustinian community, since their foundation here in 1953! Fr Michael Martel was the last Augustinian pastor of the parish. The Order was finding that its lack of vocations was impairing the ability to meet its Canadian commitments. The seminary building beside the church, with room for 29 students, wasn't being properly used because vocations had fallen off since the 1960s. It was in June 1983 that the decision was made to leave and move on. It was at that time when Fr Brendan O'Brien was named the new Pastor of St. Augustine Parish and that the Archdiocese took over the pastoral responsibility. In 1983-84 a vibrant parish community, including Fr Frank Scott) continued the journey of faith and mission! On June 27, 1984, the Augustinians sold the property next door to the Church to the Ukrainian Catholics, who would locate their seminary there. Yes, it was pivotal moment in the history of this parish. Parishioners were sad to see them leave, "it was a big void for the parish. It was a big loss. We really felt it ". A big party was held in the parish hall, on June 22, 1984, to say farewell to the Augustinians, for their faithful service and ministry!

<u>Did you know?</u> A huge part of evangelization is hospitality: the inviting and welcoming of people designed to put them at ease and to help them feel at home. For us Catholics, one of the major obstacles to our efforts at being more hospitable is making the assumption that people speak "*Churchese*," which, as the Urban Dictionary describes, is a language of "words that are common within the church setting and are familiar only to those who attend church." It is important to note; that we should shape our announcements and invitations as though they were going to people who have never darkened the doors of a church, which, in many cases nowadays, is not hyperbole. This means thinking twice about inviting people while using words, phrases, and acronyms that mean nothing to the average person who is not steeped in Catholic culture for example, RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults); GIRM (General Instruction of the Roman Missal); ALPHA (an evangelistic course that seeks to introduce the basics of the Christian faith through a series of talks and discussions) to name a few. It is also more effective to have a representative of the group or ministry to come forward to speak about the event or ministry and not just leave it for the commentator to make the announcement.

<u>Quiet time</u>: Did you know that the Church is open by 7 am in the morning (Mon. through Thurs.), for Holy hour, private prayer, and Adoration of Blessed Sacrament. Come and have quality time in prayer, even if its for only for 10 minutes on your way to work. Communion and Confession is also available at that time.
