#### DECEMBER 31, 2023 – THE HOLY FAMILY OF JESUS, MARY AND JOSEPH



The Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph Stewards Forgive "...as the Lord has forgiven you, so you must forgive." - COLOSSIANS 3:13

Forgiving is one of the hardest things for people to do. We can't give what we don't have. We need to receive God's mercy and forgiveness first before we can give it to others. 
