Sanctity and Dignity of Human Life

On Sunday Feb. 8 we mark this year's focus on the sanctity and dignity of human life. This day is the renewed form of the former Pro-Life Sunday. While it was observed in previous years on first week of May; as National march for Life, note it has been moved. At this time it is a focus on encouraging prayer, reflection, and pastoral support for the elderly, the sick, the vulnerable and those near death and their caregivers. The Church affirms the compassionate and high quality palliative care being the proper and ethical response to suffering at the end of life, providing comfort, dignity and support to both the person (patient) and their loved ones. May the spirit of our liturgies in music, prayers of Faithful and greeting each other, bring about the theme of the sanctity of human life. Special year upon us:

The special Jubilee Year of Saint Francis proclaimed by Pope Leo XIV will take place from 10 January 2026 to 10 January 2027, on the occasion of the eighth centenary of the death of Saint Francis of Assisi. The Apostolic Penitentiary, in accordance with the will of Pope Leo XIV, has issued a Decree granting the faithful the plenary indulgence during the Year of Saint Francis, celebrated on the occasion of the 800th anniversary of the death of the Saint of Assisi. The life of the Poor Man of Assisi shows that God's mercy works in history also through people who have opened their hearts to His action.

Smaller church:

It has been often said that we would eventually see a smaller church. I believe it was Pope Benedict who predicted this will happen, with his emphasis more in quality and taking seriously our Faith. Locally for ourselves as mentioned as part of the Enrolment ceremony for candidates for Confirmation; we had eleven Jan. 25. This is the lowest response to date along with First Communion, as well. What does it say with fewer Baptisms, no weddings and fewer church funerals. Only for the migrant and new Canadians we would be in serious "do-do". Do you know about a third of our parishes in the Diocese (Ottawa-Cornwall) priests from Africa and Asia? There are 133 parishes.
