“John tried to prevent him, saying, “I need to be baptized by you, yet you are coming to me?””

The Vatican released on Dec. 30 the attendance figures for liturgical celebrations in 2025, a year marked by the Jubilee of Hope, the death of Pope Francis, and the election in May of Pope Leo.
