Is confession dead? Q&A with a Catholic historian on the state of the sacrament

Only a minority of the faithful are seeking out confession at all, finds author [James O'Toole](#) in his urgent, provocative new study of the sacrament, *For I Have Sinned: The Rise and Fall of Catholic Confession in America*. Let us be clear how this Sacrament of healing and of Joy (Pope Francis reminds us) brings immense grace and blessing to all who receive. We are one of the few parishes offering the opportunity for Confession during the Holy hour of Adoration each weekday from 7 am to 8:15 as well as on Saturdays from 3 pm until 4:15pm.
