

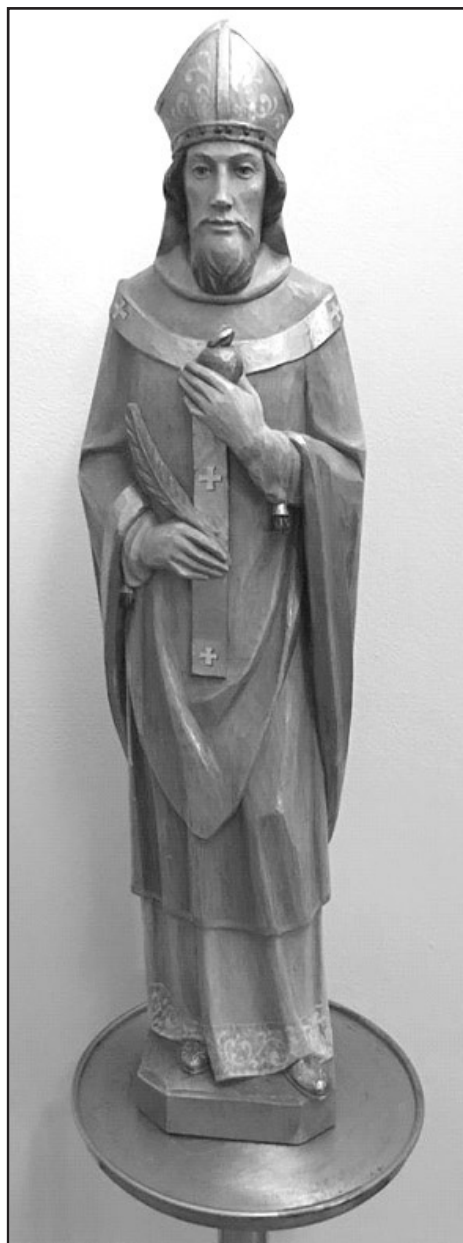

PASTOR'S DESK**A Bit of History at St Augustine's (continues):**

There is no question that the mid 1960's brought enormous changes to parish life. St Augustine parish was blessed by the leadership of the Augustinian community. There were teaching moments and workshops, reaching out to parishioners to offer assistance and formation! High Masses were discontinued in June of 1964 and the first folk Mass was held in July of 1966. In 1965, the church held a re-enactment of the Jewish Passover ritual on Holy Thursday, with a convert from Judaism, Father Goldstein, presiding. It was clearly evident, that St Augustine's was a little bit more prepared for Vatican II, and the results of Vatican II, than perhaps some other parishes because so much of the groundwork had been done. People became more involved in the management of the church as activities came under the authority of a parish council, which had its first meeting on May 6, 1970. On June 20<sup>th</sup>, the parish council decided to allow female readers and commentators in the sanctuary. Later that summer the parish youth group sponsored a Festival of Peace outdoor rock concert. St Augustine parish was one of the first churches to move its choir closer to the altar; despite some objection and it was noted that the parish was one of the first parishes to sing English, instead of Latin.

**MAiD will no doubt increase anxiety:**

The Catholic Bishops of England and Wales weighed in on reaction to a pivotal moment in society in England. *The House of Commons' approval of the Terminally Ill Adults (End of Life) Bill is a fundamental change to English society, said Cardinal Vincent Nichols in a statement released on Friday, June 20, following the vote. It was stated that it took minimal debate in Parliament about seven hours while the previous occasion on whether "fox hunting" should be allowed took ten times that amount. "The task is now clear. Every effort must be made to limit the damage that will be done by this decision" said Cardinal Nichols, President of the Bishops conference. Instead of euthanasia or assisted dying, the bishops "believe that improving the quality and availability of palliative care offers the best pathway to reducing suffering at the end of life."*

**Some thoughts for July:**

Pope Leo was speaking recently to group of Sisters at the Vatican on their journey of faith and religious life. He spoke of the eloquence of St Augustine. Note, we will hear much more about his patron since he is an Augustinian. We are particularly blessed of this wisdom!

"Saint Augustine, speaking of the primacy of God in the Christian life, affirms that, 'God is everything, your everything. If you are hungry, God is your bread; if you are thirsty, God is your water; if you are in darkness, God is your light that never fades; if you are naked, God is your everlasting garment.'" Indeed, we would do well to ask ourselves: to what extent are these words are true for me? How much does the Lord satisfy my thirst for life, love or light?"
