Stewards Share

"They all ate and were satisfied. And when the leftover fragments were picked up, they filled twelve wicker baskets." (Luke 9:17)

The story of the Loaves and Fishes shows us that when you share what you have, even if it doesn't seem like that much, miracles can happen! Do not think that your gift is too small or insignificant! Each <u>Steward</u> has a role in God's plan; you just need to place your trust in the Lord. Nothing is impossible with God. You just may be the answer to someone else's prayer.

A Bit of History (continues):

The beginnings of St Augustine church must have been an exciting time for parishioners who long awaited their new church. The founder of St Augustine Church was Rev. Cyril Smetana, who arrived from New York in big rental truck with two volunteer helpers. Neighbours were curious about what the priests and brothers were up to. They began a long tradition of helping out with tasks, like clearing the site, renovations of buildings, fundraising, food collections, driving members of the Order about, etc. At the start, neighbours had to help chase cows off the property that were interfering with the work. Keep in mind that the parish was founded in 1953. The actual church building came two years later. The present design featured eight massive laminated wooden beams with peaks 39 feet above floor level. A similar church to this one was designed for Our Lady of Fatima on Woodroffe Ave. By the following summer on July 10, 1955, at 2 pm, the sod was turned for construction for St Augustine's, that would end up costing \$178,000, not including furnishings. A group of 300 parishioners watched the ceremony as the senior choir, under the direction of Father Cyril, provided music.

The new Vision for the Archdiocese of Ottawa/Cornwall has been set in motion since May 15; when our own Archbishop passionately announced this new vision for the future. The question remains - are you on board? Will you discover via the Diocesan website, prayer and involvement to make this a reality! Please share comments to your Parish Pastoral council and Pastor.

With the conviction that God takes the initiative in all things, we choose to trust fully in His grace and loving plans for the future of the Roman Catholic Church of Ottawa-Cornwall. 


