

PASTOR'S DESK

SAINTS PETER AND PAUL, APOSTLES

Living Stewardship

"I have competed well; I have finished the race; I have kept the faith." (2 timothy 4: 7)

How many of us can say this? St. Teresa of Calcutta said, "God doesn't call us to be successful, he calls us to be faithful." How many times have we been blinded by the success of the world at the expense of our faith? Matthew Kelly says, "Take one minute each day to live Stewardship reminding yourself that you are just passing through this life and will die one day; you will live more intentionally with a passion and purpose."

A Bit of history at St Augustine's (continues):

There is no doubt that the mid 1960's brought about change in the Liturgy. I have fond memories of the workshops held here to instruct the faithful with all the changes, especially for the Sunday Eucharist.

Participation was key. As noted, the Vatican Council 11 changes brought St Augustine Church closer still to its people, generating more involvement. As part of those changes the interior of the church was redesigned under the direction of architect William More, using the craftsmanship of Mr. Schwarzkogler.

The organ console was brought down from the balcony in 1966. A 36 foot high wooden screen with cloth fabric was built behind the main altar to hide the organ pipes from view, so as not to detract from the altar.

The main altar was raised so everyone could see the Mass more clearly. In March of 1967, the new sanctuary and organ were blessed. Eventually, in 1982, the Blessed Sacrament side altar was removed and relocated to a side alcove. A beautiful bronze baptismal font with warm running water was put there in its place!

Special anniversary:

Our Pastor, Fr Frank Scott celebrates 41 years of priesthood today. It is almost rare to have the actual feast day of Saints Peter and Paul celebrated on a Sunday. In 1984, his ordination was celebrated in his home parish of St. Michael, Corkery on June 29th. It was on the Feast of the Sacred Heart, which is always celebrated on the second Friday after Pentecost. Ironically, Father Frank remarks "that he has TWO feasts to ponder and celebrate."

We gather to give thanks at this Sunday Eucharist, for his dedication and ministry all these years. You may note that he was part of the transition when he was named co-pastor with Father Brendan O'Brien in the Summer of 1984. It was at that time that the Augustinians officially left Ottawa.

He describes these past ten years as pastor here at St. Augustine's like a second coming.
