Stewardship in Relationship

"Because there is one bread, we who are many are one body, for we all partake of the one bread." 1 Corinthians 10:17

The U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops teaches us (in their pastoral letter on stewardship) that the Eucharistic celebration should lead to works of charity and mutual help. The heart of stewardship is this "Eucharistic stewardship."

What Is the Feast of Corpus Christi?

The Feast of Corpus Christi, also known as the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, is a Catholic celebration of the real presence of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist—and thus a sacred reminder that, in every Mass, Jesus' one sacrifice of Calvary is sacramentally made present and offered anew for "the forgiveness of the sins we daily commit" (CCC 1366).

The Church celebrates Corpus Christi to profess and adore our Eucharistic Lord. Jesus is truly present body, blood, soul, and divinity in the Eucharist. At every Mass we partake of the Lamb of God, the New Covenant Passover sacrifice. Not only that, but this feast also highlights the sacramental and sacrificial reality of Christ's presence. Additionally, it affirms the Church's teaching on transubstantiation and invites the faithful into deeper Eucharistic devotion.

Sacrament of Confirmation is celebrated next Saturday June 13th at 10 am. Come join us as we celebrate this Pentecost event! Archbishop Damphousse will be here to preside over 13 candidates from St Augustine, along with 9 candidates from St Elizabeth parish. Important to have a full church for such an inspiring and uplifting liturgy of Thanksgiving.

We also celebrate First communion for Katrina and Boulos at the 4:30 pm mass on June 13th and we celebrate the Gift of Baptism at our 10:30 mass for Alice Tardioli (June 14th). Blessings to all in our community support; surrounding them with the Church's prayer of guidance and Amazing Grace.
