

PENTECOST SUNDAY

Stewardship Advocate

"The Advocate, the Holy Spirit whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything and remind you of all that I told you." (John 14:26)

The materialism of our society lures us to concentrate more on what we want than on what God wants for us. The relativism of our world tells us that we should be tolerant of all things, that there is no absolute truth. Pray to the Holy Spirit to transform our lives and to guide our thoughts, words and actions. What Stewards put in their mind, heart, and soul affects actions. Put good things in and good things will come out.

<u>Pentecost comes as</u>: the "birth of the church", new beginnings, empowerment, fulfilling a promise, wait I will send you an advocate, counsellor, my Spirit who will empower you. The event of Pentecost, as recorded in the New Testament, marks a pivotal moment in Christian history, signifying the outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon the early followers of Jesus Christ. This event is detailed in the Book of Acts, specifically in <u>Acts 2</u>, and is celebrated as the birth of the Church. The Holy Spirit's descent at Pentecost fulfilled Jesus' promise to send a Helper and empowered the apostles for their mission to spread the Gospel.

I have fond memories of Holy Spirit Parish, Stittsville, where I was the Pastor for six years, from August 1994 until 2000. We gathered at the Holy Spirit school gym on Main Street, commonly called the "Holy gym". This one Pentecost, feast day, we decorated the gym with many balloons red, white, orange. One elderly parishioner walked in and said with a gasp... *this Looks like a Liberal convention (we never forgot it)*. Father Frank Scott

Bishops in France speak out:

With France poised to vote on a controversial "assisted dying" bill, the country's Catholic bishops have launched an unprecedented public campaign urging Catholics to speak out against the bill. Twelve bishops of the Paris region prayed in Notre Dame Cathedral on May 21 for the bill to be rejected. Debate continues in Parliament through May 25 before the May 27 vote. A bit of our parish history continues: On December 1, 1953, St Augustine's, was declared a parish and the people gathered for Mass in a temporary church that could handle 200 people. Four Masses were celebrated each Sunday. Those first Masses were modest gatherings. The Church, later the Knights of Columbus Hall, was originally a tool shed. However, this was a start for a church that would become a touchstone for Catholic families on the southwestern edge of Canada's capital city. The little white building is still there, on the far side of the red brick building next door, which houses the Queenship of Mary Sisters. Note this beautiful building was purchased back from the Ukrainian community six years ago. Interesting to note, back in November of 1948, Masses were being held at the Carleton Heights Public School, on Falaise Road. Some early Masses in the parish were also celebrated at St Nicholas School. The faith of the people sparked gatherings within the confines of the parish boundaries which encompassed; Baseline road on the north, Prince of Wales Drive and the river on the east side, Colonnade Road on south and Merivale Road on west side.
