Stewardship Reflections - Stewards Give

"I will be their God and they shall be my people." - JEREMIAH 31:33

What does it mean to be God's people? It means we recognize that everything we have and everything we are belongs to God. We aren't "owners" of anything, we are merely "Stewards" of the gifts God have given us. It means we are willing to use our gifts and our lives to care for our family, our neighbors and for people we don't know, just as God cares for each of us.

Please note: the third evening of the mission (Thurs, March 21st at 7:00 p.m.) will be a Penitential Liturgy, with confessions. Confession, the Sacrament of God's forgiveness, allows us to start again on the journey of new life that began with our Baptism, Pope Francis said recently during a penitential liturgy. 
